

# Elydale Elementary Remediation Plan

## 2015-2016 School Year

For the 2015-2016 school year, grades five through seven math students will receive a 106 minute English block and a 106 minute math block in order to provide remediation to students identified as struggling to meet proficiency standards. The additional time spent on these core subjects will help students with the skills they have not yet mastered.

Specialists/Title I teachers will provide targeted interventions to specific students who are identified as potentially low-achieving and/or at-risk. Specialists/Title I teachers will also assist teachers in the classroom with students identified by STAR testing along with SOL test results. These identified students will receive small-group instruction. Students can also be tutored for classroom work performance, current test performance, attendance, or other criteria which reflects a need for additional instruction.

After disaggregating Spring SOL testing data and reviewing data from benchmark assessments and STAR, Specialists/Title I teachers will collaborate with classroom teachers to ensure all students' needs are being met. Collaboration between classroom teachers and Specialists/Title I teachers makes the remediation program successful.
